is the 15th Conference in the series of events started with the workshop "Solid State Physics and Radioactive Irradiation", held in Liptovský Mikuláš, Slovak Republic, 1995. Next three years the name of this workshop was "Effect of Non-Standard External Factors on Physical Properties of Solids". Since 1999, its name has been "Applied Physics of Condensed Matter" (APCOM). APCOM provides a unique opportunity for experts in the field of applied research of condensed matter physics to come together and share their visions of future developments in microelectronic, nanoelectronic and molecular electronic technology, and in the device scientific/industrial applications. The main focus of the conference is on presentation of both theoretical and experimental results, partly also of both computer simulation results and measurements techniques in the investigation of physical properties of bulk solids, thin solid films, ultrathin organic polymer films, heterostructures, superlattices, microelectronic devices, etc., exposed to the influence of an external factors (photons, neutron and radioactive radiation, ion beams, and different device fabrication processes, respectively).

Conference layout: June 24–26, 2009. All participants are encouraged to register on Wednesday, June 24. The registration desk will be opened from 08:00 CEST. The opening of the conference will be on Wednesday, June 24, at 14:00 CEST followed immediately by the session. The programme will be closed on Friday, June 26, at 13:00 CEST. Registration details will be available for participants in the second announcement.

<u>Conference venue</u>: BYSTRÁ spa — rehabilitation institute is situated near the village of Liptovský Ján in the beutiful environment of the Jánska valley. The Jánska valley is one of the most beautiful valleys in the national park of the Low Tatras with wealth of natural

beauty and the number of thermal springs and subterranean caves.

<u>Language</u>: The official language of all presentations is English, Slovak and Czech. There will be no simultaneous translations during the conference.

Conference publication: All papers will be reviewed and published in the Proceedings. The conference participants will obtain Proceedings at the registration desk. All complete texts of papers will be written in English. Details for publishing will be available in the second announcement.

<u>Technical equipment:</u> The PC-data/video projector, will be available for oral presentation.



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
